Director's Corner

The fall edition of the newsletter is here which means cooler days are ahead. If you visited the Coshocton location during the heat of summer, you undoubtedly noticed the building was a bit warm. The existing HVAC unit that supplies climate control to the original 1917 structure is from 1980. The library has been following state laws to replace this unit. The process began in January of 2022 when the library solicited an engineer for the project. Since February, H.F. Lenz has made multiple visits to conduct research and work on drawings. This large project is on track for completion in 2023. We are thankful for receiving financial support received to date from Coshocton

Located in the basement of the library, the Books Galore Book Store has gently used books, DVDs and more for sale at rock bottom prices.


